They began offering senior retirement living options in 1972 and their mission is to provide security and peace of mind to seniors by being a preeminent provider of retirement-life services. There are a total of 26 communities at Acts that provide independent living, assisted living, and skilled nursing care options, with a total of 52 neighborhoods.

Julie Ackley, corporate director of memory care at Acts, is leading the way in senior living by working on standardizing delivery of programs to help her lead the teams she manages in the communities and neighborhoods. While staffing can be challenging, Julie and her team are making strides when it comes to offering meaningful engagement to ensure residents find meaning and purpose across multiple levels of living.

With Linked Senior, Julie has taken the innovative step of training team members outside of the enrichment department, such as certified nursing assistants, so that meaningful engagement can happen for all residents based on their preferences; even when a life enrichment professional may not be immediately available.


